2. On April 5, 2023, Appellants filed a notice of appeal of the District Court Order (D.I. 1; 1:22-cv-00951 D.I. 61). On May 22, 2023, this Court entered the Briefing and Scheduling Order (the "Scheduling

Order") (D.I. 28), establishing certain briefing and other deadlines in connection with the Appeal. Pursuant to the Scheduling Order, Appellants' opening brief (the "Opening Brief") and the joint appendix were due to be filed and served on or before July 3, 2023.

3. On July 3, 2023, Appellants filed and served their Opening Brief, together with volumes one through three of their appendix (the "Appellants' Appendix"). D.I. 29, 30. Appellees learned the contents of Appellants' Appendix when it was filed.

4. Appellants' Appendix does not include all documents from the record below that may be necessary for the Court to adequately consider the parties' briefs and the issues presented.

5. Accordingly, Appellees have prepared the Supplemental Appendix, which includes certain additional documents that are in the record below that were omitted from Appellants' Appendix. The Supplemental Appendix is organized in a manner that will assist the Court in reviewing the Answering Brief and includes documents that are in the record below and will be cited in the forthcoming Answering Brief. Accordingly, Appellees submit that the relief requested herein is warranted.
