Barretto, Barry Bahrami, Pete Stephenson, Jose Flores, 3 Andrew Harms, Dr. Sheldon Hough, DDS, the Second Amendment Foundation, 4 Gun Owners of America, Gun Owners Foundation, Gun Owners of California, Inc., 5 the Liberal Gun Club, Inc., and the California Rifle & Pistol Association, 6 Incorporated (collectively, Plaintiffs) and Defendant Rob Bonta, in his official 7 capacity as Attorney General of California (Defendant, and together with Plaintiffs, 8 the Parties), hereby stipulate and agree as follows: 9 WHEREAS, on October 3, 2023, this Court issued an order (Dkt. No. 16) 10 coordinating this case and Carralero, et al., v. Bonta, Case No. 8:23-cv-01798-11 CJC-ADSx (the Carralero Action), in "the interests of judicial economy and 12 efficiency"; 13 WHEREAS, the Parties in this Action (as well as those in the Carralero 14 Action) believe that those interests would be best served by Defendant filing a 15 single opposition brief of 17,500 words, and the same declarations in support 16 thereof, in response to the motions for preliminary injunction filed in both cases; 17 WHEREAS, the Parties in this action further agree, in light of the pending 18 Motion for Preliminary Injunction and the efforts needed from Defendant to oppose 19 it, that, with the Court's approval, Defendant's deadline to answer or otherwise 20 respond to Plaintiffs' complaint should be continued until 21 days after a ruling 21 from this Court on the Motion for Preliminary Injunction; 22 NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by the 23 Parties that, with the Court's permission: 24 Defendant shall file a single opposition brief, with a 17,500-word limit, in 25 response to the motions for preliminary injunction filed in both cases; 26 Plaintiffs will still be allowed to file their individual reply brief; and 27
