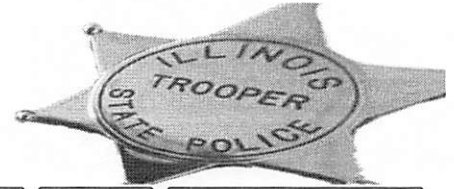

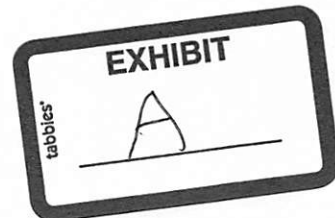
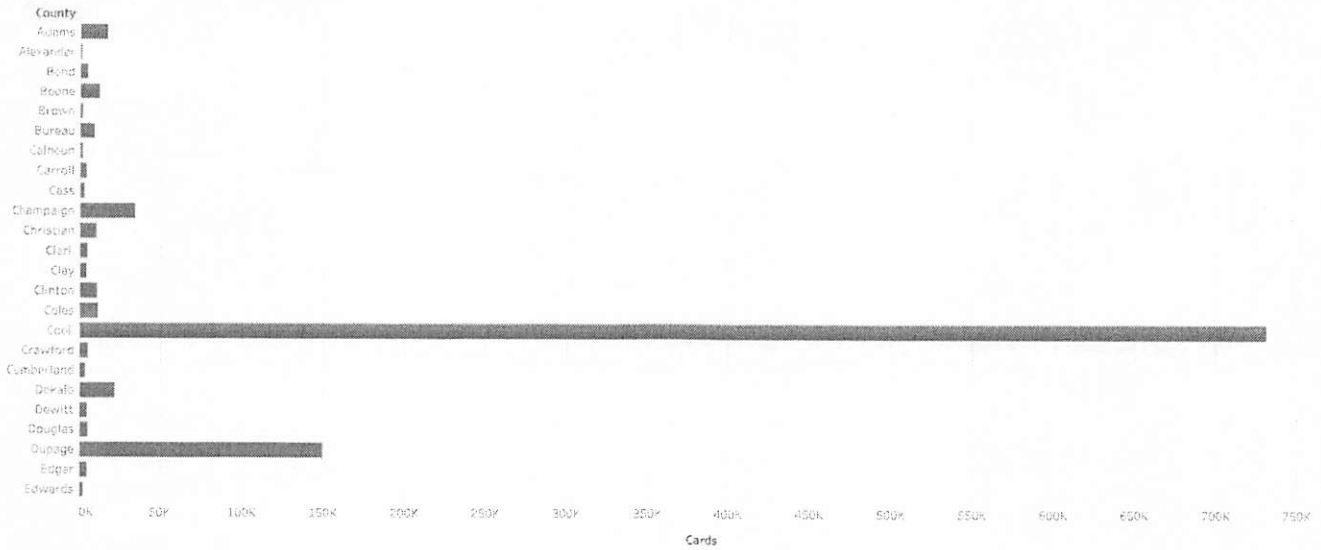

# Cook County Board Bans Assault Weapons, Toughens Penalties

The Cook County Board of Commissioners today approved changes to the county's assault weapons ban and toughened penalties for violations of the ordinance. Cook County Board President Toni Preckwinkle, Commissioner Jesus G. "Chuy" Garcia (D-7th) and Commissioner Larry Suffredin (D-13th) sponsored amendments to the "Blair Holt Assault Weapons Ban," named for the son of a Chicago police officer who was killed in a 2007 shooting while protecting a high school classmate. The changes update, define and expand various categories of assault weapons whose sale, possession or ownership are banned in Cook County. The amended ordinance sets out in great detail the specific weapons that are covered by the ban. The County Board's action follows recent approval of the state's concealed carry law, which gives local governments a deadline by which they need to address changes in their own ordinances governing possession of guns. "We must do what we can to stem the tide of gun violence and keep weapons with high levels of destructive capability out of circulation," President Preckwinkle said. "This amended ordinance recognizes the challenges we face in Cook County and puts in place responsible and meaningful laws aimed at protecting our residents and law enforcement officers." The amended assault weapons ordinance will increase penalties for violators of its provisions. Any person found in violation shall be subject to a fine of between \$1,000 and \$5,000. The previous fines ranged from \$500 to \$1,000. A subsequent violation of the ordinance could bring a fine of up to \$10,000. Individuals found in violation may still be sentenced for a jail term of up to six months. The ordinance exempts any firearm that has been made permanently inoperable or is an "antique firearm," or weapons designed specifically for Olympic target

**Editor's note**— Section 4 of Ord. No. 22-099, adopted August 16, 2022, states the following: "SECTION 4: Effective date and Pre-existing purchasers. This Ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2023, (the "Effective Date"), except as follows: Any person that can demonstrate to the satisfaction of the City Attorney that the Commercial Sale of an Assault Rifle was completed prior to the Effective Date of January 1, 2023, which means that prior to January 1, 2023, the purchaser completed an application, passed a background check, and has a receipt or purchase order for said purchase, without regard to whether the purchaser has actual physical possession of the Assault Rifle, shall be considered a pre-existing purchaser. For said pre-existing purchaser, the delivery of physical possession of the Assault Rifle may be completed, even if such activity would otherwise be in violation of the new provisions of Chapter 19 (Regulation of the Commercial Sale of Assault Rifles) of Title 3 (Business and License Regulations). Notwithstanding the foregoing, if physical possession of the Assault Rifle will not occur until more than sixty (60) days following the Effective Date of this Ordinance, that person is not a pre-existing purchaser and said purchase shall constitute a violation of the provisions of this Chapter."

3-19-1: - DEFINITIONS:

The following words and phrases shall, for the purposes of this Chapter, have the meaning ascribed to them by this Section, as follows:

	<p>(2) A semiautomatic rifle that has a fixed magazine with the capacity to accept more than ten (10) rounds, except for an attached tubular device designed to accept, and capable of operating only with, .22 caliber rimfire ammunition.</p>
	<p>(3) Any part, combination of parts, component, device, attachment, or accessory that is designed or functions to accelerate the rate of fire of a semiautomatic rifle but not convert the semiautomatic rifle into a machinegun.</p>
	<p>(4) All of the following rifles, copies, duplicates, variants, or altered facsimiles with the capability of any such weapon thereof:</p>

shooting events. The 2015 Firearm Weapons Ban Applies to All municipalities in Cook County unless a municipality has its own law on the books. In a separate action, the Board also approved an ordinance proposed by President Preckwinkle and Commissioner Garcia that establishes guidelines and penalties concerning access to firearms and ammunition by minors. The "Protection of Minors" ordinance prohibits the sale or transfer of any firearm or ammunition to a minor, defined in the ordinance as any person under the age of 21. It further sets specific rules that firearms owners must follow to secure weapons and prevent access to those weapons by minors, such as storing them in locked containers separate from ammunition or equipping them with trigger locks. "Today's headlines are filled with stories of homicides and suicides of young people, as well as children accidentally shooting themselves or a sibling," Garcia said. "It is our responsibility to ensure the most vulnerable in our society are safe. As an elected official I am sworn to protect them. The passing of the "Protection of Minors Ordinance" is yet another step in my strategy to develop a comprehensive public safety and anti-violence action agenda in Cook County." Penalties for violating the ordinance include a mandatory fine of \$1,000 for the first offense and a fine of up to \$2,000 for each repeat offense. The ordinance includes a provision that exempts access and use of a firearm by a minor in a lawful act of self-defense, in the defense of another person, or if a minor gains access to a firearm through unlawful entry. Also exempted are law enforcement officers and members of the armed forces or National Guard while engaged in their official duties. "This is a common sense approach to making sure children do not have unrestricted access to weapons and will hopefully prevent the kinds of incidents we hear about all too often, where youngsters find loaded weapons with tragic results," President Preckwinkle said. Both ordinances go into effect immediately.

<b>BARREL SHROUD:</b>	A shroud that is attached to, or partially or completely encircles, the barrel of a firearm so that the shroud protects the user of the firearm from heat generated by the barrel but excluding a slide that encloses the barrel.
<b>COMMERCIAL SALE OF ASSAULT RIFLES:</b>	The sale or offer for sale of an assault rifle when the sale requires the seller to have a valid certificate of license issued pursuant to the Illinois Firearm Dealer License Certification Act (430 ILCS 68/5-1 et seq.).
<b>DETACHABLE MAGAZINE:</b>	An ammunition feeding device that can be removed from a firearm without disassembly of the firearm.

FIXED MAGAZINE:	An ammunition feeding device that is contained in and not removable from or permanently fixed to the firearm.
FOLDING, TELESCOPING, OR DETACHABLE STOCK:	A stock that folds, telescopes, detaches or otherwise operates to reduce the length, size, or any other dimension, or otherwise enhances the concealability, of a firearm.
FORWARD GRIP:	A grip located forward of the trigger that functions as a pistol grip.
LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER:	A person who can provide verification that they are currently employed by a local government agency, state government agency, or federal government agency as a sworn police officer or as a sworn federal law enforcement officer or agent.
PISTOL GRIP:	A grip, a thumbhole stock or Thordsen-type grip or stock, or any other characteristic that can function as a grip.
THREADED BARREL:	A feature or characteristic that is designed in such a manner to allow for the attachment of a device such as a firearm silencer or a flash suppressor.

3-19-2: - PROHIBITION OF THE COMMERCIAL SALE OF ASSAULT RIFLES:

1. The commercial sale of assault rifles within the City is unlawful and is hereby prohibited.
2. The provisions of this Chapter shall not apply to the commercial sale of assault rifles to:
  - 2.1. Any federal, state, local law enforcement agency;
  - 2.2. The United States Armed Forces or department or agency of the United States;
  - 2.3. Illinois National Guard, or a department, agency, or political subdivision of a state; or
  - 2.4. A law enforcement officer.

3-19-3: - ENFORCEMENT:

Any person or entity who violates any of the provisions set forth or referenced in this Chapter shall be subject to the following:

1. A fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for a first offense within a 12-month period, and a fine of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) for a second or subsequent offense within a 12-month period.
  - 1.1. Each day that a violation of this Chapter continues shall be considered a separate and distinct offense and a fine shall be assessed for each day a provision of this Chapter is found to have been violated. Notwithstanding the forgoing, the escalation of fines as set forth above shall not occur until a prior adjudication of a violation against the same person or entity has been entered.
2. Any violation of the provisions of this Chapter may be deemed a public nuisance and abated pursuant to all available remedies, including but not limited to injunctive relief. In addition to the penalties provided for in Section 3-19-3:1 above, the City shall be entitled to reimbursement for the cost of the City's reasonable attorney's fees and all costs and expenses incurred by the City to abate any entity operating as a public nuisance. Said attorney's fees and said costs and expenses shall be paid to the City within sixty (60) days of issuance of a bill therefor unless an alternate timeframe is agreed to in writing by the City Manager.

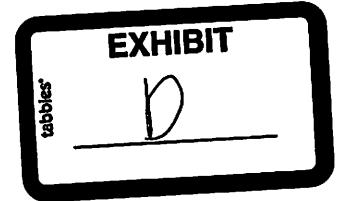

**SWORN STATEMENT OF SCOTT PULASKI**

Comes now Scott Pulaski, and states under penalties of perjury, as follows:

1. I have been asked to review a list of screenshots, of attempted firearm registrations under the Protect Illinois Communities Act.
2. That SWD made M-11 pistols, which are covered under PICA.
3. MAS, which is short for the Manufacture d'armes de Saint-Étienne is a French arsenal that made several firearms that are available on the U.S. market that are covered under PICA.
4. Inland Division of General Motors made millions of M1. Carbines, including the folding stock M1A1 carbine, during World War II, as depicted in the State's PICA identification guide.
5. Other M1 carbines were made by National Postal Meter, Saginaw Steering Geer, Commercial Control Corporation, IBM or International Business Machines and other companies, all of which will accept the same folding stock.
6. FN Columbia, SC is the marked maker of the FN PS90, regulated under PICA by name.
7. TNW made certain firearms that might be PICA regulated.

8. Bushmaster Firearms is a now defunct manufacturer of XM15E2S rifles that are likely PICA regulated. At one time Bushmaster was the largest manufacturer of centerfire semiautomatic rifles patterned on the AR15 rifle.
9. Olympia Arms is also a now defunct manufacturer of PICA regulated firearms, both rifles and pistols, patterned, in part on the AR15 rifle.
10. Izhmash is a Russian company, listed as the maker of various PICA regulated firearms in the statute itself.
11. Browning itself made or imported many PICA regulated firearms, these included FAL pattern rifles.
12. From my observations, it would appear that if a given manufacturer is not listed in the PICA registration database, there is no way to actually register a PICA firearm from that manufacturer.
13. There appears to be no option to click "other" or type in a new manufacturer name.
14. It appears that if the manufacturer category is black<sup>gnk</sup>, the registration form will not be accepted.

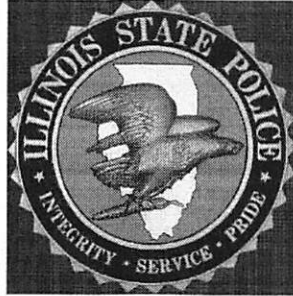
(6) ".50 caliber cartridge" means a cartridge in .50 BMG caliber, either by designation or actual measurement, that is capable of being fired from a centerfire rifle. The term ".50 caliber cartridge" does not include any memorabilia or display item that is filled with a permanent inert substance or that is otherwise permanently altered in a manner that prevents ready modification for use as live ammunition or shotgun ammunition with a caliber measurement that is equal to or greater than .50 caliber.

(7) "Detachable magazine" means an ammunition feeding device that may be removed from a firearm without disassembly of the firearm action, including an ammunition feeding device that may be readily removed from a firearm with the use of a bullet, cartridge, accessory, or other tool, or any other object that functions as a tool, including a bullet or cartridge.

(8) "Fixed magazine" means an ammunition feeding device that is permanently attached to a firearm, or contained in and not removable from a firearm, or that is otherwise not a detachable magazine, but does not include an attached tubular device designed to accept, and capable of operating only with, .22 caliber rimfire ammunition.






## The M1 carbine guide

You will find here a thorough study of the M1 carbine (United States Carbine, Caliber .30, M1) over the period 1941-45. We will first discuss the basic concepts, then we will see in more detail the characteristic elements of the M1 carbines of the second war.

### History of the US M1 Carbine

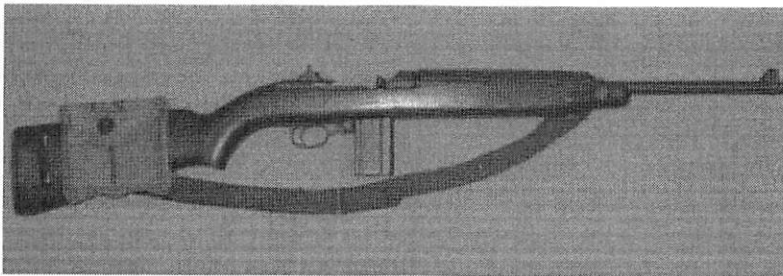
Since 1938, the **US Army** has been eager to equip non-combatant troops with a semi-automatic rifle, less bulky, lighter and more maneuverable than the **Garand**.

It was not until 1940 that the Ordnance Corp. accepted the request. The green light was given in 1941 to the various arms manufacturers to launch the competition. More than 20 prototypes were then submitted to the US Army. After a year and a half, the choice will be made for the Winchester model and will take the designation of M1 Carbine (<https://www.militaria-deal.com/militaria-army/us-militaria>).

Between 1941 and 1945, more than 6 million USM1 rifles were produced by 12 different contractors. Inland, Winchester, Underwood, National Postal Meter, Quality Hardware, IBM, Saginaw (Michigan, Grand Rapids), Standard Products, Rock-Ola, Irwin-Pedersen, Commercial Controls. This mass production makes the M1 rifle the most produced American weapon during WW2 (<https://www.militaria-deal.com/top-ww2-militaria>).

The commissioning will be done from June 1942. The rifle was an immediate success thanks to its lightness and maneuverability (it could be held with one hand) and this despite its lack of power.

It equipped from then on the units of support and support (transmission, artillery, transport, ...). A version with folding stock was developed for the airborne troops under the demomination 'M1 A1 Carbine' (<https://www.militaria-deal.com/militaria-army/us-militaria>).
