**[PROPOSED] ORDER DENYING

1           Having considered Plaintiffs’ motion for preliminary injunction, the briefs  
2 filed in support and opposition, any other documents and files, and oral argument on  
3 the motion, the Court finds that the Plaintiffs failed to show that they are likely to
