23 appearing, hereby GRANTS the Joint Stipulation and ORDERS as follows:

- 24 1. The motion cut-off date is continued to March 22, 2024, and the last
25 hearing date for dispositive motions is continued to May 10, 2024.
- 26 2. Defendants will withdraw their pending motion for summary judgment
27 by March 15, 2024;
- 28 3. Defendants shall file a new motion with a single supporting

1 memorandum of points and authorities that does not exceed 13,000 words no later
2 than March 22, 2024;

3 4. Plaintiff shall have a total of 13,000 words for opposition, which shall
4 be filed no later than April 12, 2024;

5 5. Defendants' reply brief, if any, will be subject to the standard 7,000-
6 word limit;

7 6. The matter will be heard by this Court on May 10, 2024 at 9:30 a.m.
8 [OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE:]

9 1. The Parties' stipulation is denied; and

10 2. Plaintiff will have until March 29, 2024, to file her opposition to the
11 pending motion, and her word limit is increased to 13,000 words.
