[PROPOSED] JUDGMENT

1 The motions for summary judgment filed by Defendant Rob Bonta, in his  
2 official capacity as Attorney General of the State of California (Dkt. 149), and  
3 Plaintiffs Steven Rupp, Steven Dember, Cheryl Johnson, Michael Jones,  
4 Christopher Seifert, Alfonso Valencia, Troy Willis, Dennis Martin, and the  
5 California Rifle & Pistol Association, Inc. (Dkt. 150), respectively, came on for  
6 hearing before this Court on September 8, 2023. Deputy Attorney General John D.  
7 Echeverria appeared on behalf of Defendant Rob Bonta, as Attorney General of the  
8 State of California. Sean A. Brady and Konstadinos T. Moros of Michel &  
9 Associates, P.C., appeared on behalf of all Plaintiffs. After considering the moving  
10 and opposing papers and evidence, and the arguments of counsel at the hearing, the  
11 Court issued an order granting Defendant Attorney General's motion for summary  
12 judgment and denying Plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment. (Dkt. 173.)

13 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED  
14 that Judgment is entered in favor of Defendant Rob Bonta, as Attorney General of  
15 the State of California, and against Plaintiffs Steven Rupp, Steven Dember, Cheryl  
16 Johnson, Michael Jones, Christopher Seifert, Alfonso Valencia, Troy Willis, Dennis  
17 Martin, and the California Rifle & Pistol Association, Inc. Plaintiffs shall take  
18 nothing by way of their Third Amended Complaint from Defendant Rob Bonta, as  
19 Attorney General of the State of California. Each and every claim and prayer for  
20 relief asserted in Plaintiffs' Third Amended Complaint is denied. Defendant is the  
21 prevailing party and shall be entitled to recover reasonable costs of suit. Defendant  
22 may submit a "Bill of Costs" and an "Application to the Clerk to Tax Costs" to  
23 recover any eligible litigation costs in this action. *See* C.D. Cal. R. 54-2, 54-2.1.
