**THIRD JOINT STIPULATION TO
CONTINUE DEADLINE TO FILE
STIPULATION RE: DISMISSAL OR
MOVE TO REOPEN CASE**

Pursuant to Local Rule 7-1, Plaintiff Ana Patricia Fernandez and Defendant Los Angeles County, through their counsel of record, jointly request that this Court continue the deadline to file a stipulation for dismissal or motion to reopen this case.

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2024, the parties filed a Notice of Settlement (Dkt. No. 100) informing this Court that, having participated in a settlement conference with the Honorable Magistrate Judge Patricia Donahue, the parties successfully reached a full settlement of the case;

WHEREAS, on July 19, 2024, the Court issued a Minute Order (Dkt. No. 101), placing this case in inactive status and ordering the parties to “file either (1) a stipulation and proposed order for dismissal of the action or judgment, or (2) a motion to reopen if settlement has not been consummated” by November 16, 2024;

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2024, the parties filed a joint stipulation and proposed order to continue the deadline to file either a stipulation for dismissal or a

1 motion to reopen the case (Dkt. No. 102);

2 WHEREAS, on November 18, 2024, the Court granted the request and continued
3 the deadline to December 16, 2024 (Dkt. No. 103);

4 WHEREAS, on December 13, 2024, the parties filed a second joint stipulation and
5 proposed order to continue the deadline to file either a stipulation for dismissal or a
6 motion to reopen the case (Dkt. No. 105);

7 WHEREAS, on December 16, 2024, the Court granted the request and continued
8 the deadline to April 15, 2025 (Dkt. No. 106);

9 WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to all material terms, and the final settlement
10 agreement was approved by the Los Angeles County Claims Board on March 17, 2025.

11 WHEREAS, the Parties previously informed the Court in the Second Joint
12 Stipulation to Continue Deadline to File Stipulation Re: Dismissal or Move to Reopen
13 Case (Dkt. No. 105) that the settlement is *typically* processed (e.g., a settlement check is
14 issued) within 4-6 weeks after approval. But counsel for Plaintiff has not yet received the
15 settlement check, and counsel for Defendant understands that it might take another 60
16 days for the settlement check to be processed and delivered;

17 WHEREAS, one last continuance is necessary to give the County time to fulfill the
18 terms of the now-approved settlement; and

19 WHEREAS, a brief continuance will conserve the resources of both the parties and
20 the Court while final action from the County is pending.

21 THE PARTIES HEREBY STIPULATE AND JOINTLY REQUEST that the Court
22 issue an order continuing the deadline for the parties to file either (1) a stipulation and
23 proposed order for dismissal of the action or judgment or (2) a motion to reopen if
24 settlement has not been consummated until June 16, 2025.
