1 Plaintiffs Poway Weapons & Gear, Inc. and SGR Ventures LLC (hereafter, “Plaintiffs”)
2 and Defendants California Department of Tax and Fee Administration and Trista Gonzalez, in her
3 official capacity as Director of the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration
4 (hereafter, “Defendants”), through their counsel of record, (collectively “the Parties”) stipulate
5 and request that the Court order as follows:

6 WHEREAS, Defendants filed a Demurrer to the Complaint on October 27, 2025.

7 WHEREAS, Plaintiffs filed their Motion for Summary Judgment on April 8, 2026.

8 WHEREAS, on May 13, 2026, the Court on its own motion continued Defendants’
9 demurrer hearing by fourteen days from May 14 to May 28, 2026.

10 WHEREAS, the Parties met and conferred on the briefing schedule via emails on May 19
11 and 20, 2026.

12 WHEREAS, Defendants have reserved September 8, 2026 for the hearing on the Motion
13 for Summary Judgment.

14 WHEREAS, the Parties wish to establish a briefing schedule that would conserve judicial
15 resources and allow the Parties and the Court to resolve the contested issues in the case efficiently
16 following resolution of the demurrer.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties stipulate and request that the Court order as follows.

18 1. The hearing on Defendants’ demurrer shall remain on May 28, 2026 at 9:00 a.m.;

19 2. All deadlines related to the Parties’ Motions for Summary Judgment shall be
20 extended by fourteen (14) days;

21 3. Defendants’ Combined Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment and Opposition to
22 Plaintiffs’ Motion for Summary Judgment shall be due on June 19, 2026;

23 4. Plaintiffs’ Combined Opposition to Defendants’ Cross-Motion for Summary
24 Judgment and Reply to Defendants’ Opposition to Summary Judgment shall be due on August
25 19, 2026;

26 5. Defendants’ Reply to Plaintiffs’ Opposition to Defendants’ Cross-Motion for
27 Summary Judgment shall be due on August 28, 2026;

28 6. The hearing on Plaintiffs’ Motion for Summary Judgment and Defendants’ Cross-

1 Motion for Summary Judgment that was scheduled for August 25, 2026 shall be taken off the
2 calendar.

3 7. The hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment and Defendants' Cross-
4 Motion for Summary Judgment shall be on September 8, 2026 at 9:00 a.m.
