Respondent California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Respondent or Department) and
Petitioners Safari Club International, et al. (Petitioners), by and through their respective counsel,
hereby enter into the following Stipulation and request that the Court issue it as an order.

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RECITALS

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2026, Petitioners filed a Verified Petition for Writ of Mandate or Other Appropriate Relief (Petition) alleging violations of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000 et seq.);

WHEREAS, on or around March 18, 2026, the Department was served with the Verified Petition and Complaint, accompanying summons, and Petitioners’ Election to Prepare Administrative Record of Proceedings;

WHEREAS, the current deadline for the Department to certify the administrative record is May 18, 2026;

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code section 21167.6, subdivision (c), allows the time limit for certifying the administrative record to be extended by stipulation of the parties;

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to stipulate to an extension until Friday, July 17, 2026, to prepare and certify the administrative record in this case;

WHEREAS, the Superior Court of Los Angeles County, Local Rule, rule 2.232(d) contains various provisions for a respondent preparing the administrative record to provide a petitioner preliminary and updated costs estimates, which are not relevant given Respondent’s agreement to prepare the record at its own cost, and the requirement to provide the parties with a draft index, which the parties wish to modify; and

WHEREAS, the parties may agree to further extensions of time as necessary.

STIPULATION

THEREFORE, Petitioners and the Department, by and through their respective counsel, hereby stipulate, and the Court hereby orders as follows:

1. The deadline for preparation and certification of the administrative record shall be extended until July 17, 2026, and the parties may agree to further extensions of time as necessary.
2. The provisions of Local Rule 2.232(d) are waived, except that the Department will provide at least 21 days for Petitioners to review the record and record index


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before certifying the record, and the parties will meet and confer regarding any potential additions to or deletions from the record.
